Additional requirement for the admission

Additional requirements include checking and assessing the student's musical-auditory skills in written format. The applicant must identify: notes in the clefs of Treble and Bass; all major, minor and perfect intervals; Note durations and rest durations (the whole, half, quarter, eighth, and sixteenth); Student must be able to determine the musical meter/time signature of a given sample (simple and complex); Must recognize instruments united in each group of symphonic orchestra. The applicant must also be able to identify: relatively difficult rhythmic structure based on audio recording, Major and Minor scales, different registers and timbres (on the example of a fragment from a musical sample).

The test is evaluated by hundred (100) - point System; Positive assessment is 51-100; (Working Time - 1 astronomical hour).
